1. NAME OF THE VETERINARY MEDICINAL PRODUCT

Veriben. Soluble granules for solution for injection. Protozoocide.

2. COMPOSITION

For the 2.36 g sachet:

Diminazene diaceturate Excipient (Antipyrine) q.s.	-
For the 23.6 g sachet:	
Diminazene diaceturate	10.5 g
Excipient (Antipyrine) q.s.f	1 sachet (23.6 g)

3. **PROPERTIES**

The active ingredient of VERIBEN[®] is diminazene diaceturate, drug of the diamidines family. Diminazene is highly active against both Trypanosoma and Babesia spp. It is also of value in the treatment of theileriosis due to *Theileria annulata*.

Diminazene has become the most commonly used therapeutic agent for trypanosomosis in animals.

The antipyrine, included in the excipient, ensures a complete solubility of the active ingredient and acts as an help to struggle against inflammation and fever.

4. INDICATIONS

Cattle, sheep, goats: Treatment of protozoan diseases:

- Trypanosomosis due to Trypanosoma congolense, T. vivax and T. brucei.
- Piroplasmosis due to Babesia bovis, B. bigemina, B. ovis, B. motasi.
- Theileriosis due to Theileria annulata.

5. ADMINISTRATION AND DOSAGE

Deep intramuscular route.

The recommended dosage is 3.5 mg of diminazene diaceturate per kg bodyweight in a single injection. Do not exceed a total dose of 4 g of active ingredient in any animal.

Cattle, sheep, goats: Prepare the injectable solution by adding 15 ml of sterile water to each 2.36 g sachet. For the 23.6 g sachet it is necessary to add 150 ml of sterile water. Mix well water and powder before sucking the sterile solution into the syringe. Inject the prepared solution according to the following table:



Body weight	Volume of the reconstitued solution	As quantity of diminazene diaceturate
100 kg	5.8 ml	350 mg
200 kg	11.5 ml	700 mg
300 kg	17.3 ml	1050 mg
400 kg	23.0 ml	1400 mg

One injection is enough for the treatment.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

Do not administer to other species than those registered.

SIDE EFFECTS

Spermatic decrease may be produced sometimes on caprine after a daily administration of VERIBEN[®].

8. PRECAUTIONS

In case of large volume to be injected, it is recommended to divide it into two separate sites. Keep out of reach of children.

9. WITHDRAWAL PERIOD

<u>Meat:</u> 21 days.

<u>Milk:</u> 3 days.

10 STORAGE CONDITIONS

Sealed sachets can be stored in a cool dry place below 30°C.

The reconstituted solution can be stored during 15 days in a fridge, protected from light and in a closed glass bottle.

11. PRESENTATIONS

Box with 10 x 2.36 g sachets Box with 10 x 23.6 g sachets.
